MedLife consolidates its position in the southeast of the country and inaugurates the second hyperclinic in Galați

November 28, 2019, Galați: MedLife, the leader of the private medical services market in Romania, continues the expansion plans and opens the second hyperclinic in Galați, which offers ambulatory and imaging services in Galați. The investment in the new medical unit was approx. 1.5 million euros.

The MedLife Galați Hyperclinica (str. Nicolae Bălcescu 24A) covers an area of 550 square meters and offers patients multidisciplinary medical services and treatments for 17 specialties, including pediatrics, pediatric cardiology, pediatric surgery, pediatric orthopedics, neuropsychiatry, pediatric neuropsychiatry ENT, infectious diseases, allergies, pneumology, oncology and ophthalmology.

The new unit, close to the first MedLife hyperclinic in Galați, is distinguished by an imaging department, equipped with a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) 1.5 Tesla, a 4D Voluson ultrasound, as well as other equipment. The new clinic consists of 12 medical offices for clinical and paraclinical consultations and investigations, and the medical team consists of approx. of 20 employees, doctors and support staff.

"This new hyperclinic opening is part of our national development program and marks the strengthening of the leading position of private medicine in the south-east of the country. We are glad that we can offer patients in Galați and in the vicinity a second medical unit, where they will be able to benefit from medical services to the highest standards. As we announced to our shareholders and investors, we have started to expand and continue at the same accelerated rate. We will continue to prospect the market for national expansion in cities with a medium population, both through acquisitions and through green field projects" said Mihai Marcu, President and CEO of MedLife.

MedLife opened the first hyperclinic in 2004, and at present, the company owns 21 such units in Bucharest, Arad, Timișoara, Galați, Iași, Constanța, Craiova, Brașov, Cluj, Ploiești and Oradea.
