

MedLife continues territorial expansion and opens the first large clinic in Târgu Mureș

- The latest MedLife hyperclinic covers an area of 1000 square meters and is the result of an investment of 2 million euros.
- The clinic in Târgu Mureș supports the Group's mission to provide patients with integrated diagnostic and treatment medical services.
- Currently, MedLife is the operator with the largest network in Romania, operating in over 230 clinics, hyperclinics and medical centers nationwide.
- Beyond the organic expansion in cities not yet covered, MedLife also focuses its efforts on the M&A program, the latest companies integrated in the group being Neolife and OncoCard. Following the completion of these acquisitions, MedLife became the operator with the most powerful diagnostic and treatment platform in Romania for oncological pathology.

Târgu Mureș, June, 2022: MedLife, the leader of the private medical services market in Romania, reconfirms its territorial expansion plans by inaugurating the first large medical clinic in Târgu Mureș. The new multidisciplinary unit provides patients in the center and north of the country with **16 medical and surgical specialties** for consultations, investigations and minor surgeries, ensuring an **integrated circuit of investigation, diagnosis and treatment**.

MedLife Târgu Mureș Hyperclinic covers an area of 1000 square meters and includes 12 medical offices, a sampling point, an imaging department equipped with MRI and other medical equipment, a small surgery room and an investigation room. The investment for the opening of this unit amounts to 2 million euros.

"We continue to consolidate MedLife network in medium and large cities and we are glad that we can offer the inhabitants of the central and northern part of the country quick access to integrated medical services, at European standards, in the latest Târgu Mureș Hyperclinic. **We are proud of the largest network of clinics and medical centers in the country, MedLife being present in over 25 cities, and our goal is to systematically continue this consolidation process.** In fact, at present, any patient can reach a MedLife unit in about an hour by car, regardless of the area in which they are located, which is an extremely important advantage in facilitating access to quality medical services" said Mihai Marcu, President and CEO of MedLife Group.

The multidisciplinary team within Târgu Mureș Hyperclinic consists of over **36 experienced doctors**, who cover a wide range of medical and surgical specialties. Among the medical specialties available in the Hyperclinic are: internal medicine, cardiology, gastroenterology, neurology, endocrinology, dermatovenerology, dermatocosmetics, allergology, pneumology and rheumatology. At the same time, in the area of surgery, patients have specialists in orthopedics - traumatology, general surgery, cosmetic surgery and reconstructive microsurgery, neurosurgery, ENT and obstetrics - gynecology for minor interventions.

The imaging investigation department offers patients from Târgu Mureș high quality examinations through the latest equipment and software. The clinic has an MRI and 6 modern ultrasounds for

investigations such as ultrasound of the heart, abdomen, pelvis, thyroid, testicle, soft parts, breast and axilla, Doppler vascular ultrasound and musculoskeletal system.

MedLife's newest hyperclinic also has a functional examination room, where patients can benefit from investigations such as an EKG, spirometry, effort test, EKG holters or blood pressure holters.

MedLife launched the concept of "hyperclinic" in 2004, with the inauguration of MedLife Grivița Hyperclinic in Bucharest, the largest clinic in MedLife's portfolio. This concept refers to a large clinic, which brings together under the same roof clinical and paraclinical investigations, from laboratory tests and imaging services to medical consultations and investigations for all medical specialties.

MedLife currently operates in almost 700 of its own and partner locations, including over 230 clinics, hyperclinics and medical centers, with the largest network of healthcare facilities nationwide.
